



2022 Annual General Meeting: Amendments to the Constitution

Following discussion, the Board of Achterarder Community Sports and Recreation (ACSR) is proposing the following amendments to the Constitution:

Clause 19	
Amend from:	If a member or charity trustee of the organisation requests a copy of the register of members, the board must ensure that a copy is supplied to him/her within 28 days, providing the request is reasonable; if the request is made by a member (rather than a charity trustee), the board may provide a copy which has the addresses blanked out.
Amend to:	If a member or charity trustee of the organisation requests a copy of the register of members, the board must ensure that a copy is supplied to him/her within 28 days, providing the request is reasonable; if the request is made by a member (rather than a charity trustee), the board may provide a copy which has all personal details blanked out.
Clause 111	
Add 111.3	"meeting" is taken to mean a physical or virtual meeting
Add 111.4	"signed" may be by electronic signature or handwritten signature
Add 111.5	"written application for membership" may be a paper form or an on-line form

The change to Clause 19 reflects an update that ACSR may, subject to the formal approval of a member, hold more personal information than just their address.

The additions to Clause 111 clarify the interpretation of terms, with some of the activities of the charity now being hybrid or virtual.
